Kamerata Novi Sad is the City Chamber Orchestra of Novi Sad and one of Serbia's leading chamber ensembles. Building on the artistic legacy of Kamerata Academica, founded in 1988 by Professor István Varga, the orchestra was re-established in 2007 by cellist and Artistic Director Marko Miletić. Recognized for refined chamber music-making, original productions and innovative concert concepts, Kamerata combines artistic excellence with interdisciplinary collaborations.

Highlights include Carmina Burana with Stefan Milenković, Report on the Blind featuring John Malkovich and Anastasia Terenkova, Blue Danube Orchestra, Viva Ennio Morricone, Gran Pasión Tango, Classics Meets Jazz and Let's Dance. The orchestra collaborates with internationally acclaimed artists, supports young musicians through educational programmes, and received the Orchestra of the Year Award in 2025.
